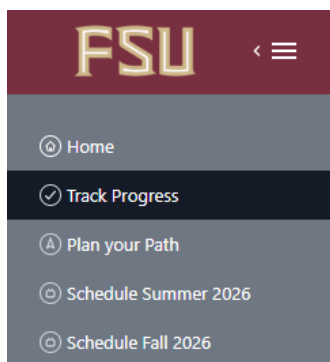


HOW TO VIEW TRANSFER AND ACCELERATED CREDIT IN STELLIC



Prior to meeting with an academic advisor to develop a Degree in Three Program of Study, you must verify that all test credit, dual enrollment, and/or transfer credits are posted to your FSU record.

You can view this information from the *Track Progress* page in Stellic. Scroll down and select the *Courses* tab. Review the credit posted under the *Transfer Credits* heading.
